2. **Update: Public Safety Concerns at O'Malley Rd. & Rockridge Dr. and O'Malley Elementary:**  
The MOA Traffic Engineering Department has completed their review of community public safety concerns regarding the safety and accessibility for pedestrians, especially the children in our community, who will attempt to cross O'Malley Rd. at Rockridge Dr. once the SOAK Phase II O'Malley Reconstruction project is completed.

Background: The Hillside Community Council and community members have expressed concerns that installment of pedestrian paths on the north and south sides of O'Malley as a part of the Phase II project will result in an increased likelihood of children and pedestrians attempting to cross at Rockridge to get to O'Malley Elementary, without traffic calming or pedestrian safeguards in place at this location.
