- **8.** <u>JBRR Update:</u> Joy Boston reported on Memorial Day events, June 4 Arctic Valley Run, July 30-31 Arctic Thunder. Reported that the Government Hill gate to the base will be closed from May 31 until July 8. Joy can be contacted at joy.boston.2@us.af.mil
- **Anchorage School District:** Margo Bellamy reported on last day of school for students. Noted summer learning programs. Noted no school board meeting for July. Reported on Board election of officers—she was re-elected Board president. Noted last day of work for departing Superintendent Bishop.
- 10. <u>Anchorage Fire Department:</u> Chief Schrage reported on the extreme wildfire danger
- 11. <u>Anchorage Police Department:</u> Officer Melissa Lambert reported on the mobile crisis line and the call volume.
- 9. Old Business: Jody Sola reports that the GHCC executive committee met regarding the State redistricting and submitted a resolution opposing the map that placed Government Hill with Eagle River. Jody also noted that there has been a change in leadership at the Heritage Land Bank. Also mentioned the resolution that was submitted regarding the zoning on the property on the East Side of the Hill. Jody also reported she had submitted a letter as requested listing our priorities for capital projects for the neighborhood.
- 10. <u>Business Reports</u>: Port of Alaska: Steve R reported (1) the Petroleum and Cement Terminal will be completed in the coming months. He hopes there will be some type of ribbon cutting ceremony when the facility is opened. (2) Reviewed the status of the MARAD lawsuit, with the defendants having until April 25 to file any notice of appeal. If there is an appeal, the dispute should be resolved within a year. (3) The USS Anchorage will be in port from June 7 to June 11 for the first time since it was
