- MUNI Road Maintenance/Restoration

- Paving for CAR/Basher Rd. in the area near Basher Trailhead by the MUNI Street Maintenance Dept. has been funded by unused funds leftover from other projects. However, we are facing difficulties getting the work actually scheduled for this year. MUNI PM&E tells me that we will not lose the funding if the work is not performed this year. I hope to have at least some good news by this BCC meeting.

So far, no one has told me that they do not wish to remain in their current position. Nominations for Board Members will be accepted at this September Basher Community Council meeting.
