

1 **Bayshore Klatt Community Council Resolution**

2 Opposition to CEA Communications Tower

3
4 **WHEREAS**, the Bayshore Klatt Community Council (BKCC) is an all-volunteer,
5 self-governing neighborhood organization as stated in Article III of the Municipal
6 Charter, and

7 **WHEREAS**, the Bayshore Klatt Community Council exists to afford citizens an
8 opportunity for maximum community involvement and self-determination, to
9 provide a direct and continuing means of citizen participation in local affairs, and
10 to preform those functions and exercise those powers granted or permitted by
11 the provisions of municipal code 2.40.050 and 2.40.060, and

12 **WHEREAS**, The communities of Bayshore, Southport, and Concord Hills are
13 distinctive, planned communities which maintain high standards of aesthetics,
14 ambience and curb-appeal, and

15 **WHEREAS**, The proposed substation upgrade at 100th and Southport Drive
16 includes an industrial-style 65-foot tall communications tower unlike any found
17 anywhere else in the area, and

18 **WHEREAS**, The proposed tower would be placed in a most prominent location of
19 the most prominent intersection in the Bayshore-Klatt area, and

20 **WHEREAS**, Installation of such a tower would detract significantly from the
21 aesthetics of the intersection and the community.

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that Bayshore-Klatt Community
23 Council opposes the substation re-work as presented and requests that the
24 Municipality and Assembly do not approve any permits for the site that include an
25 over-sized communications tower.

26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, Any work done on the substation should be
27 reviewed by and receive the endorsement of the Bayshore-Klatt Community
28 Council before any permits are granted by the Municipality of Anchorage.
