LRSA Report, Ted Trueblood

The LRSA report is as follows:

1. Summer work program included approximately 4,000 lineal feet of new RAP on Atelier, Burning Bush, Nearpoint and Basher;

2. The RAP work at the top end of Basher required widening the road to avoid encroaching on private property. The road now meets fire lane standards;
3. Heavy brush cutting occurred at the end of the season;
4. Culvert repairs at the Stuckagain Creek crossing Basher took 2 tries and hope it alleviates winter icing; and,
5. Budget: healthy—at 1.25 mils the tax rate for our LRSA is one of the lowest in Anchorage.

ByLaw Change

Secretary Margaret Nelson presented the bylaws for approval. The council approved two bylaw changes, as amended. The bylaws now go to the Municipal Assembly for approval. See attached bylaws.
