"Scales" on the Fish Creek Trail

The Fish Creek Trail bike tunnel under Spenard Road showcases new art by local artist Sheila Wyne. The mosaic art titled "Scales" is a 60-foot-long frieze made of decommissioned street signs. The wear and tear of these surfaces all have unique stories, like each experience on our



unique trail system. The concept envisions a repeating pattern of salmon skin/scales with fluid, riffle lines hinting at the movement of water as it flows over the surface of the scales. The shimmering effects will be especially dramatic in winter months when head lamps illuminate it.
