Abbott Loop Community Council Resolution in Support of the proposed Spruce Hollow Subdivision and the use of the undeveloped adjacent Rights of Ways for a greenway development to contain a path or trail and the realignment of the area's drainage into this area.

WHEREAS, a presentation were made at the January 25th, 2024 General Membership Meeting, hosted on Zoom and in person, regarding Spinell Homes Inc.'s intention to realign an existing drainage into currently undeveloped Right of Ways for 72nd Avenue and Spruce Street, creating a "greenway" which would also contain a pedestrian pathway in conjunction with the development of a 21 lot Subdivision known as Spruce Hollow and platting case #S12763

WHEREAS, this proposal creates needed housing and aims to improve two unimproved Rights of Way, public land, into a park like setting that will contain area drainage that eventually ties into the North Fork of Little Campbell Creek along with a pedestrian pathway. This will make a formal connection between two parts of the neighborhood promoting non-motorized travel and recreational activities.

WHEREAS, the proposal is alignment with:

Anchorage 2040 LUP:

LUP 8.2. Provide new and improved trails, greenbelts, and other pedestrian facilities as alternative travel ways connecting open spaces, neighborhoods, and centers.

Anchorage 2020:

Policy 50: Healthy, mature trees and forested areas shall be retained as much as possible.

Policy 65: Promote and encourage the identification and conservation of open spaces, including access to greenbelts, Chugach State Park, Anchorage Coastal Wildlife Refuge, and Far North Bicentennial Park. **Policy 66**: Fish, wildlife, and habitat protection methods shall be addresses in land use planning, design, and development processes.

Policy 67: Critical fish and wildlife habitats, high-value wetlands, and riparian corridors shall be protected as natural open spaces, wherever possible.

Policy 70: The ecological and drainage functions of Anchorage's aquatic resources shall be protected and where appropriate, restored.

Policy 80: Utilities shall be located and designed with balanced regard for the environment, energy conservation, reliability, visual impacts, natural hazard survivability, and cost.

Policy 86: Encourage public/private collaboration for acquisition, development, and maintenance of recreational spaces, parks, sports fields, public use facilities, and trails

NOW, therefore Abbott Loop Community Council supports the proposal by Spinell Homes and Spruce Hollow Subdivision to improve and utilize the 72nd and Spruce Street Rights of Ways adjacent to the project to create a greenway with drainage and a pedestrian pathway.
