C-PACER Loan Closing

This month, the largest C-PACER (Commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy & Resilience) financing in Alaska was announced for the Aviator Hotel (239 W 4th Ave). The \$5.5 million loan package from PACE Loan Group will fund energy efficiency improvements that will result in operational savings for the property.
