Lake Hood

Lake Hood Seaplane Base is officially open for float operations as of May 6th. While the weather has been temperamental this year with a very late spring, ANC Operations and Lake Hood staff have cleared the lake of any debris and float plane season has begun.

4th Floor Parking Garage

The 4th floor of the South Terminal parking garage will be closed for repairs from April 1st to July 31st. Cars currently parked on the 4th floor will be permitted to remain until midnight on April 14th, after which they will be towed to an offsite parking spot by Republic Parking. Following extensive repairs to the parking garage last year, it has been determined that the fourth floor requires additional repairs this summer.

In March 2024, Officer Nolin completed K9 handler training in Alabama. During this 7-week course, the handler is matched with a K9 and they learn to work as a team to find narcotics. As an additional certification in the training program, Officer Nolin and K9 Yara became one of the first Alaskan K9s certified in the specific detection of Fentanyl.

Yara is charging ahead to take Methamphetamine, Heroin, Cocaine, and Fentanyl off Alaskan streets.
