Dear Assembly Members,

Turnagain Community Council (TCC) is writing you to express support for AO 2022-109, an ordinance to amend Municipal Code to increase the fine for muffler and exhaust system violations.

The Turnagain neighborhood faces a serious hazard to public health and welfare and the quality of life due to illegal, loud vehicle noise. Therefore, TCC supports code changes to establish a sound level standard measured at the tailpipe that is practical for the Anchorage Police Department (APD) to enforce. Increasing the fine for violations will encourage compliance since it is a correctable citation. We support the increased fine for violations of excessive traffic noise that are not resolved by fixing faulty equipment.

The fine increase is compelling and reasonable; therefore, TCC urges the Anchorage Assembly to pass AO 2022-109, increasing the fine to \$300 per violation, as the current \$100 fine proves insufficient to deter illegal vehicle noise.
