**Project Description:** Through this project we will construct a new vehicle access control gate at Airfield Maintenance West and install head bolt outlets at the taxiway A and DeHavilland Avenue snow disposal sites.

The existing Airfield Maintenance West gate is a padlock swing gate. Replacing this gate with a vertical access control gate will allow Airfield Maintenance expedited access between landside and airside operations areas and help increase security. The snow disposal sites currently do not have electrical power. Airfield Maintenance requires heavy equipment like dozers and loaders at these sites during the winter and need the head bolt outlets in order to keep the equipment in a state of readiness.

**Project Name:** Anchorage Airport Firing Range Maintenance

**Project Number:** CSAPT01152

**Project Description:** Perform deferred maintenance on the active firing range at the Anchorage Airport by removing lead bullets and bullet fragments. Treat remaining affected soil with a heavy metal fixation reagent to prevent leaching of lead. Pistol and rifle firing ranges have the potential to create lead contamination in soil and groundwater from bullets fired during training and target practice. The Anchorage Airport will implement Best Management Practices for the removal of spent cartridges, lead bullets, bullet fragments, and shot from the earthen target backstop and adjacent areas. In addition, the pH of soil will be adjusted to minimize lead leachate and migration. Treatments will be added to the disturbed soil to make the remaining lead less leachable.

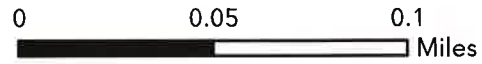
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# Anchorage Airport Old Airfield Maintenance Gate Map

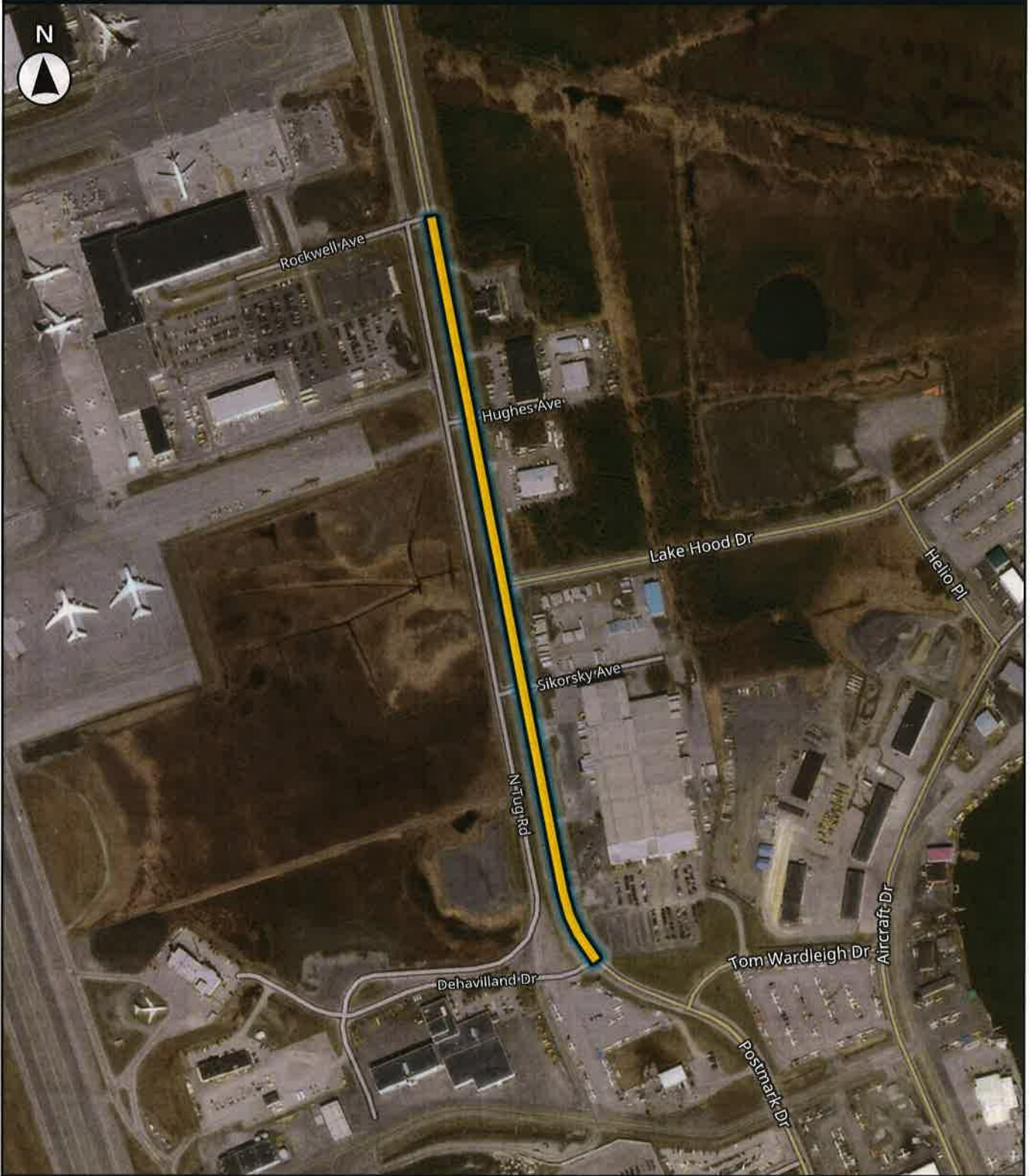



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# Anchorage Airport Postmark Drive Repairs 2024 Map

The lighting duct system that lies within the runway service area of runway 7L/25R contains all the runway and taxiway circuits' home runs that run from various areas of the field back to the airport's lighting regulator vault. The manholes of the duct system have drainage issues and are often filled with 3' to 6' of water. During the winter months this becomes ice. The circuits are frozen in ice, which causes circuit breaks in the winter, requiring emergency repairs and runway and taxiway closures.

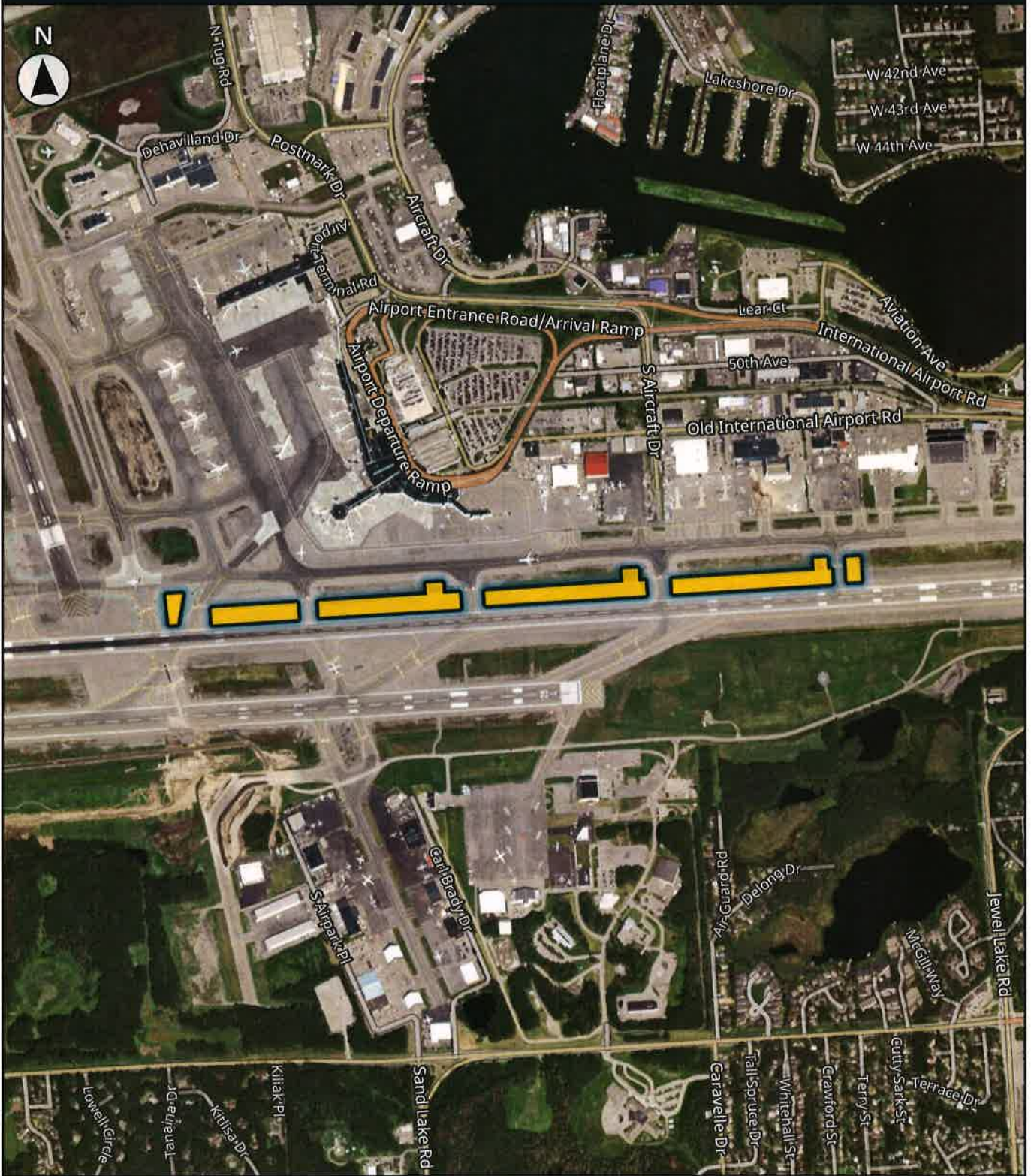

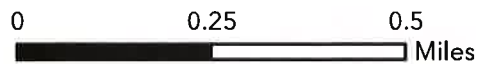
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# Anchorage Airport Runway 7L25R Lighting Duct Drainage Improvements Map

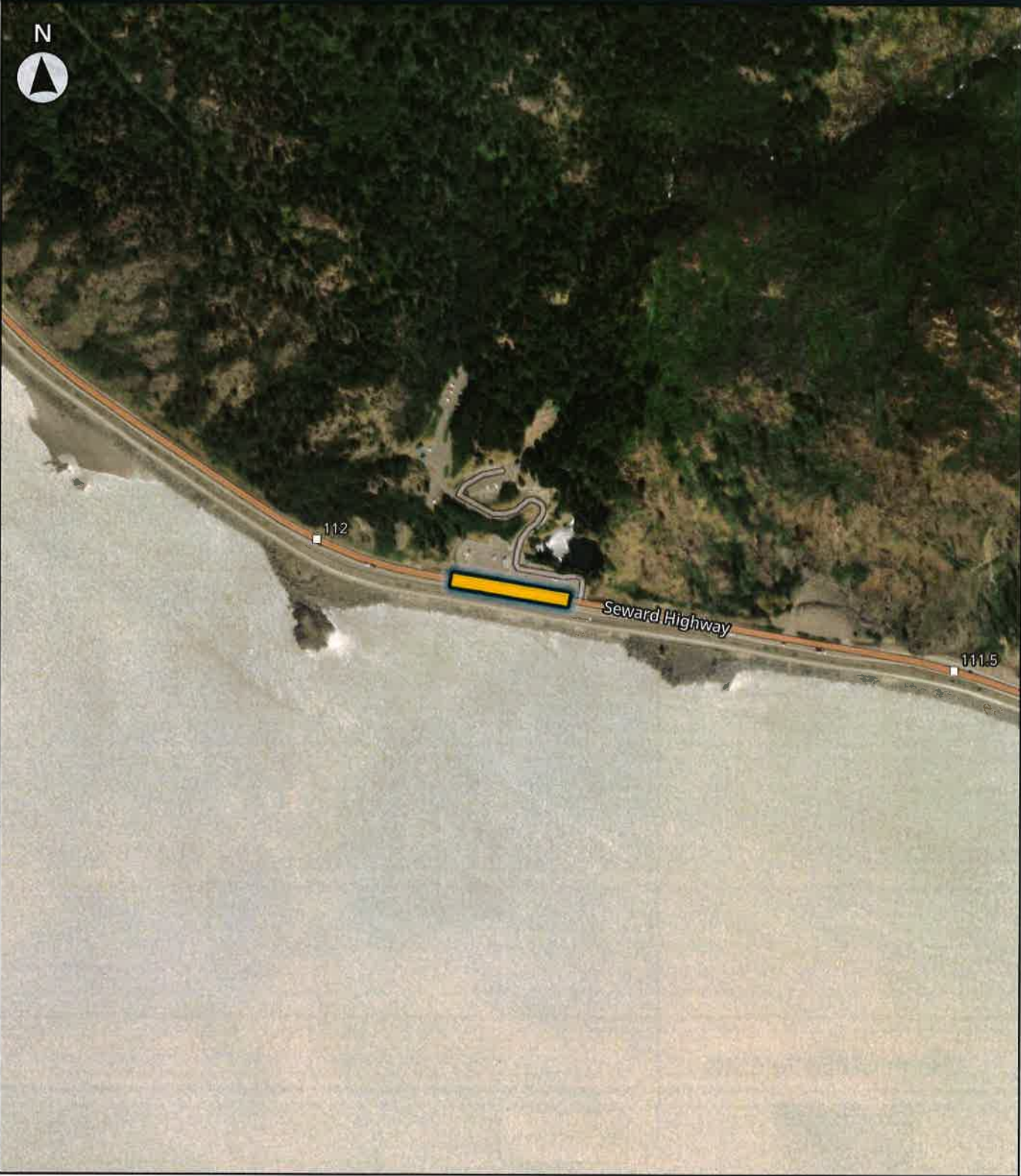


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# Anchorage Area Drainage Improvements FY 2019 Map
