One time increase to BSA of \$680 + student transportation. \$1360 PFD + \$200 energy rebate. Increase in funds to snow removal. \$4M for homeless shelter this summer on E 56th in the old solid waste building. Funding for GH school roof replacement

Port of Alaska: Steve Ribuffo

Last week – first cruise ship – will have total of 3 this summer.

First of 5 cement ships is in. Requests feedback from CC RE: lights on at night. A computerized system is helping with decreasing neighborhood impact. May have night operations this winter, would like to receive continued reports on lights once it starts getting dark again.

GHCC President said it is like night and day – all good. By end of May port offices should be out of old building, demolition will follow. Serves at pleasure of the mayor, may not be reappointed by new mayor.

• Habitat for Humanity-Lieza Wilcox (Board member) & Julia Roberts (Dev Dir)-15 mins Gearing up to restart construction of Habitat homes.

Recruiting for board. Interested in GH, HUD grants require board members to be below median income.

Just under 120 homes constructed in Anchorage over 30 years

Next to 2-3 years plan to build 12-15 homes and interest free loans.

\$25K from Forest Service to combat invasive species

\$14K matching grant for signage in parks. Parks committee is working on 'Welcome to Government Hill' sign.

Justin Sturn with Greatland Tree Service – spray for spruce bark beetles \$275 to set up, the \$40/tree – if everyone wanted it, it could be \$50 set up then 40 per tree. Also does injection – systemic for tree – 11\$ inch diameter and lasts for 2 years. May pencil out rather than \$50 +\$40 per tree 907-205-0300
