SUMMARY

Culminating with a successful first Townhall, the FCC had an eventful September. At the last Board meeting, we hosted a dialogue on Transit Supportive Housing with Anchorage Housing Club. FCC's Outreach Team helped neighbors at Anchorage Park Foundation's Park+Trails Recreation Fair find their local Community Council. Staff met with multiple potential partner organizations to discuss ways to educate the public on the importance of Community Councils, including re-engaging with a long-time partner League of Women Voters.
