

The Midtown Park Chalet will be owned by the Municipality of Anchorage and Managed by a private Property Management Team. The multi-user recreation center accommodates Rental and Retail categories, hosting events such as as indoor exercise, training, Skate invitationals, weddings, meetings, and more. The chalets construction will increase Midtown Parks current rental rate and demand. Visitors create an ongoing demand by needing to eat, warm up, repair their equipment, or recover from outdoor activity as they visit the park.


