Agenda Overview

- Lyn Ary Park Baseball Field Realignment and Park Improvements- A representative from the Parks Dept will discuss plans for realignment of the ball fields and improvements to the park.
- Runway 7R Extension. The Anchorage International Airport is working on an Environmental Assessment involving the proposed extension of one of its two east-west runways. It would require re-routing the Sisson Look Trail which is located on Anchorage Heritage Land Bank Property and extension of new runway approach lighting onto the Heritage Land Bank Property. The Federal Aviation Administration would require access to the proposed relocated Approach Lighting System towers in order to have the ability to address maintenance needs as soon as they arise. This has implications for the Sisson Loop Trail because portions of the Sisson Loop trail overlie and cross the access road.

- The Chester Creek Force Main Discharge Structure under Turnagain Street just south of Northern Lights Boulevard needs to be repaired to address deteriorating concrete. Construction is expected to occur in the June/July timeframe and will result in some temporary traffic delays on Turnagain Street.
- Traffic Calming TCC participated in the identification of traffic calming projects in our area. Two traffic calming locations have been designed and after public input have been re-worked. Come see how the Milky Way and McKenzie Dr. Projects have been reworked and provide feedback.

Turnagain Community Council Meeting Minutes Summary January 8, 2009

- I. *Turnagain Neighbors Association*. Rachel Christy provided an overview of the work of the Neighbors Association. Please join at www.Turnagainneighbors.com.
- II. *Lyn Ary Park*. The realignment of the trail west of Lyn Ary Park and ballfield realignment will be done in August. Parks will make a presentation of the design at the February TCC Meeting.
- III *Lyn Ary Park Lawsuit*. Municipal attorney Bob Owens provided an overview of the lawsuit brought by Matthew Fink, Diane Wilke, David & Jacquelyn Wilder, and Annalesa Anderson Thomas claiming ownership of land along the coastal trail and the memorial garden at Lyn Ary park. Mr. Owens is looking for information concerning changes made to the plats between 1952 1957; any notices sent to neighbors/landowners when the coastal trail was built; and about the sale of property by Union Bank to the City.
- IV. West Anchorage District Plan. Tyler Robinson, MOA/Planning Dept., and Jon Isaacs, URS, announced the initiation of the development of a long-awaited West Anchorage District Plan. TCC intends to be actively engaged in the process and will be meeting with the Muni, its consultants and other Community Councils about participation in the plan.
- V. North Airpark Development. TCC adopted a resolution opposing further development at the Northair Park until completion of the West Anchorage District Plan, the airport determines the noise, traffic and air traffic impacts of the project, and the Airport provides noise/traffic mitigation measures and preserves the needed vegetation/land buffers along Pt.
