Turnagain Community Council Meeting Minutes Summary April 2, 2009

- I. *Marston-Foraker Project update*. Sewer lift station, pump station vaults and sewer mains are installed. In 2008, 1025 truck tips completed. There were more poor soils than expected, so expecting another 1000 trucks this summer. Bringing in more but hauling out less this year. Bulk of hauling will be in June. Three to five truck trips per day now, until road restrictions hit and then truck numbers will drop. Will be starting pump station building this week. Next be building retaining walls on Lyn Ary and on Foraker. Completion should be by third week in August. Cost is anticipated to be 5% above estimated so far. Will do everything possible to open the parking lot before Little League. Plan is to put the fencing back up on Iliamna.
- II. Westside Anchorage Plan. Jon Isaacs from URS Corporation gathered input for the West Anchorage Plan. Isaacs provided handout outlining the Visioning Workshop Agenda. The intent is to provide more neighborhood direction to municipal decision-making. Airport or airport issues on Westside are a big issue. Area includes North of Dimond to south of Westchester. Eastern edge is not well defined. Purpose of the plan is to provide direction for land use, transportation, public facilities, recreation, and water and air quality. To get input from the TCC members, Isaacs conducted a brainstorming session. He asked for each member of the audience give input into what they thought should be 1) The objectives of the plan, 2) what they thought are strength and values of the Westside neighborhood and 3) what they thought are weaknesses and problems of the neighborhood. We were asked to begin brainstorming solutions and actions. A West Anchorage plan subcommittee signup sheet was circulated.
- III. *Glass Recycling resolution*. TCC adopted a resolution to encourage the City to preserve options for long-term glass recycling. The resolution asks the city to consider setting aside a section at the landfill to dump glass so that it can be recycled should market conditions change. Nine in favor and one opposed.
