Wisconsin Street Sewer Line Repair Project. AWWU is undertaking a sewer repair project to address corroded concrete sewer pipe under Wisconsin, West 29th and Turnagain St. Traffic along Wisconsin Street will be impacted by the project. The plan is to employ trenchless technology to slip in a replacement pipe inside the existing pipe.

Turnagain Community Council
Meeting Minutes Summary June 3, 2010

I. *Lyn Ary Tennis Court Application.* Bill Bittner gave a presentation concerning a challenge grant application to the Anchorage Parks Foundation to resurface the Lyn Ary Park Tennis courts.

II. *Woodland Park Cleanup and Celebration.* TCC members were invited to the Woodland Park cleanup and celebration on June 12 by the Filipino American Society of Anchorage. The Filipino American Society has adopted Woodland Park and has obtained a challenge grant for improvements to the Park.

III. *West High-Romig Middle School Master Plan.* The Council heard a more detailed presentation from the consultants working on the West High-Romig Middle School Master Plan project and State DOT concerning the traffic routing options around Carrs/Safeway and Northern Lights and Benson.

IV. *2011 Capital Improvement Projects.* TCC voted to submit amended CIP rankings based on its prior rankings prior to the Governor's veto of several projects considered funded in the TCC's May rankings.

V. *Fish Creek Culvert Project at 35th and McRae.* Representatives from DOWL Engineers gave a very interesting report concerning the rehabilitation of Fish Creek and the culvert realignment project which is part of the larger 35th and McRae Road Project.

VI. *Balto Seppala Boardwalk Project Update.* The City has finalized its construction drawings, successfully obtained the Corps of Engineers Permit and the Right of Way permit for the boardwalk and trail construction. The City approved a trails contractor on a term contract to perform the work. There will be a volunteer component to the Trail project this summer to assist with the trail construction portion of the project.
