NOTE FROM HLB:

Municipality of Anchorage's Online Public Notice web site was introduced and available to the public as of mid-March of this year. With the Assembly's passage of AO 2009-134 on January 12, 2010, the legal responsibility for advertising items to be notice in the newspapers was lifted. The Online Public Notice Web site was developed for MOA departments to begin posting public notices in a much more cost effective and efficient manner on the Muni.org website. Through August of this year, notices continued to also be published in the newspaper (Alaska Journal of Commerce) until the contract was completed August 31st.

AS OF SEPTEMBER 1, THE MUNICIPALITY WILL NO LONGER REGULARLY PUBLISH PUBLIC NOTICES IN EITHER THE ANCHORAGE DAILY NEWS OR THE ALASKA JOURNAL OF COMMERCE.
