Meeting Minutes Summary September 2, 2010

**I. *Wisconsin Ave – Turnagain Street Sewer Line Project*** AWWU discussed a sewer repair project it is undertaking to address corroded concrete sewer pipe under Wisconsin, West 29<sup>th</sup> and Turnagain St. Traffic along Wisconsin Street will be impacted by the project. The plan is to employ trenchless technology to slip in a replacement pipe inside the existing pipe. The project will start along Turnagain Street this fall. Work on Wisconsin will be next year.

**II. *Lake Hood Strip Property Acquisition EA Comments***. TCC members discussed and approved a comment letter on the Ted Stevens Airport's proposal to purchase six home on Wendy's Way that are located in the runway protection zone of the Lake Hood air strip. **III. *Lyn Ary Memorial Garden Community Maintenance Work***. TCC voted to formally adopt the Lyn Ary Park Memorial Garden as a TCC project. This will involve conducting periodic weeding, watering and cleanup of the garden. TCC in conjunction with TREErific and other community volunteers has been doing volunteer work at the garden for many, many years. TCC voted to formalize our efforts and to reimburse the Anchorage Park Foundation for mulch used to spruce the park up this summer. TCC discussed adopting other parks in the future as well.
