Turnagain Community Council  
Meeting Minutes Summary October 7, 2010

**I. Aviation Committee.** TCC Aviation Committee Chair Pat Kelly reported on the first organizing meeting of the committee.

**II. Wisconsin Ave – Turnagain Street Sewer Line Project.** Josh Shakelford of AWWU updated us on the sewer repair project AWWU is undertaking to address corroded concrete sewer pipe under Wisconsin, West 29<sup>th</sup> and Turnagain St. Traffic along Wisconsin Street will be impacted by the project. The plan is to employ trenchless technology to slip in a replacement pipe inside the existing pipe. The project will work along Turnagain Street this fall. Work on Wisconsin will be next year.

**III. Nominations.** Nominations were received for one board position, vice-president, and secretary-treasurer. We still need nominations for president and a board position. Additional nominations and the election will be held at our November meeting.

**IV. FCC Survey Budget Request.** The TCC passed a resolution supporting the Federation of Community Council's request to the Assembly for \$20,000 appropriation to support area surveys by four of the citywide community councils each year. The resolution asked FCC to work with the University of Alaska in helping the four individual councils develop effective surveys.

**V. Municipal Budget Discussion.** Assemblymembers Ernie Hall and Harriet Drummond held a workshop and discussion on municipal budget options. Copies of the Citizen's Guide to the Municipal Budget is available from council members or the Mayor's Office.
