Meeting Minutes Summary November 4, 2010

I. *Enstar Gas Contract.* John Simms, Manager of Corporate Communications for Enstar Natural Gas, gave the council a presentation concerning new gas contracts and costs for 2011.

II. *Elections.* There was much discussion about nominations for officers. Written ballots were accepted. The successful candidates were Pat Kelly and Bill Wortman for board; Barb Jones, Secretary/Treasurer; Chris Habitch, Vice-President; and Cathy Gleason, President.

III. *Neighborhood USA Convention.* Dick Tremaine discussed the FCC hosting Neighborhood USA Convention. In 1992, Anchorage hosted the convention. There are workshops and neighborhood tours, and a suggestion to include Turnagain as a tour. There are six tracks: community safety; green community initiatives; etc. If your community hosts a tour, it must provide dinner for the group. If you have ideas or suggestions go to nusa2011.org. The council adopted a resolution to make an application for a TCC tour for the FCC NUSA convention. IV. *AWWU Turnagain Street Sewer Upgrade – End of Season Report.* There was a brief discussion of the Turnagain Street Interceptor Sewer Upgrade Project is complete for the season.

V. *Homeless Camps.* Ed O'Neill from Anchorage Responsible Beverage Retailers Assoc., Laura Reisinger, from Churchill Drive Neighborhood Watch and Jeff Mittman from Alaska ACLU discussed challenges and possible solutions concerning homeless camps and homelessness in Anchorage.
