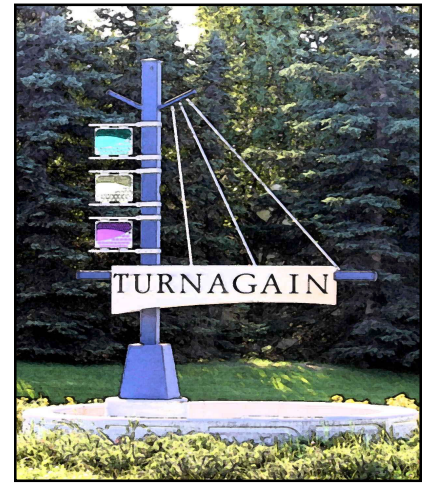

**Summary of Decisions & Motions Passed at
Turnagain Community Council Meeting January 6, 2011**

- A motion was made by Breck Tostevin and seconded by Dan Gleason to approve the December 2, 2010 meeting minutes. Motion passed unanimously.
- A motion was made by Frank Keen and seconded by Joan McKinnon to have Cathy Gleason remain as the Turnagain Community Council representative on the Federation of Community Councils delegate board. Motion passed unanimously.

While no formal motions were passed,

- An informal poll was taken regarding allowing residents to shoot personal fireworks within the MOA on New Year's Eve: 9 opposed, 6 supported.
- Assembly member Ernie Hall passed out ballots to mark whether one supports a 3-lane or 4-lane design for Spenard Road between Hillcrest Drive and 31st Ave. Ballots will not be tallied for each council; they will be tallied as a whole after voting has taken place at various community council and other public meetings.
