Amory: Capital budget updates:

\$20 k for Fairview Revitalization plan, \$40 k for laptop cart,

Mark Madden: Director SWS MOA. Brian Vanderwood: collection manager. Recycling program has changed how SWS does business. Savings in Work Comp claims, More collection per day. With recycling, some things are going to change. They will assess individual alleys. Alleys will be assessed just prior to implementation. Fall 2012. We will have assessments 60 days before then. Alleys are picked up now south of 15th ave Nelchina/Medfra/Orca.
- SWS has priorities of efficiency and safety that favor street pickup. The neighborhood has identified the desire to continue alley pickup. A FVCC taskforce will be established to identify problem alleys with SWS well in advance of the rollout.

Discussion Items:

SJ Klein proposed a neighborhood-wide garage sale - potentially in September. Event would include a map of Fairview with fundraising and advertising elements to bring shoppers into the neighborhood and promote the event. Chris constant moved that the Council authorize \$500 seed money for expenses for a neighborhood wide garage sale. Heidi Seconded. Discussion and questions ensued. 11 in favor, none opposed, Geoffrey Humphreys abstains and requests his abstention to be recorded.
