Project Updates

OFFICIAL STREETS & HIGHWAYS PLAN

On Nov. 7th, the Planning & Zoning Commission REJECTED TCC's request that W. Northern Lights Blvd. be designated a Neighborhood Collector between Wisconsin St. & Postmark Dr. (currently it is a Minor Arterial). A Collector status would restrict thru heavy-weight commercial truck traffic from using WNL.

The commission also REJECTED the Muni's compromise recommendation for a Neighborhood Collector designation on WNL between Aero Ave. & Postmark Dr.

The Assembly will have a public hearing on the OS&HP sometime in early next year. Stay tuned for hearing date.

WEST ANCHORAGE DISTRICT PLAN

Despite testimony from 29 people (mostly from Turnagain) opposing the Comprehensive Land Exchange and/or another North-South Runway, as proposed in the draft WADP, on Nov. 14th, the Planning & Zoning Commission recommended approval of the Plan AS IS, with absolutely NO DELIBERATION of the complex issues within the document. NO acknowledgement of testimony or written comment. NO discussion on ANYTHING IN THE PLAN. NO CHANGES. They spent less than five minutes on this important planning document for West Anchorage after hearing two nights of public testimony.
