Potential New Issue for Turnagain Residents

• 80-Bed Facility for Correctional Residents at "Long House Alaskan Hotel" at 4335 Wisconsin Street As of the release of this email newsletter, I have not received any specific information or formal notice from the following department or agency. However, a Turnagain resident provided TCC with information regarding the Department of Corrections or Anchorage Community Mental Health purchasing the Long House Alaskan Hotel on Wisconsin St. for the purpose of placing their population of chronically mentally ill residents there as a means of relieving overcrowding in prison facilities.

According to information this resident provided to TCC, the Long House facility would be unregulated, "essentailly a hotel," with a staff of four per shift for 80 residents.

As you know, this hotel is in a residential area of Turnagain. Depending on the scope of this potential facility, this may be of concern to nearby residents. *I will try to find out more information to report by Thursday's TCC meeting.*
