Project Updates

• West Anchorage District Plan:

The WADP Assembly Public Hearing Scheduled for APRIL 17TH HAS BEEN POSTPONED to a future date, which has not yet been announced. TCC will send out a notice as soon as we are notified of a new hearing date.

TCC needs your support on critical issues in the Plan, including telling the Assembly you:

- Oppose any land exchange that would trade a section of the **EXISTING** Coastal Trail and Pt. Woronzof Park dedicated parkland to the Airport to build another North-South Runway or other airport development.
- Support parkland status for the Coastal Trail & Greenbelt Buffer west of the Airport on Heritage Land Bank land.
- Support identifying Turnagain Bog and areas now being used as parkland on Airport property on the Land Use Plan Map as "Areas that function as Park and Natural Resources" NOT "Major Transportaion Facilities."

• Turnagain Crossing Development:

On March 13, the Assembly unanimously approved the rezoning of the property on the southwest corner of W. Northern Lights Blvd. and Turnagain St. to "B-1A SL" (Local Neighborhood Business with Special Limitations). TCC President Cathy Gleason testified at the hearing in support of the rezone to allow for the proposed Turnagain Crossing bistro/coffee shop and residential units.

• 2035 Metropolitan Transportation Plan:

TCC's comments include our request to delete from the Plan a proposal to construct a sidewalk and new multi-purpose trail along W. Northern Lights from Postmark Dr. to Nathanial Ct. Assembly public hearing is set for April 10th.
