Project Updates

● West Anchorage District Plan:

The Assembly did NOT hold a Public Hearing on April 17th. As of the email of this agenda, **A NEW DATE for the ASSEMBLY PUBLIC HEARING on the WEST ANCHORAGE DISTRICT PLAN HAD NOT been announced,** but will probably be **sometime in MAY.**

● 2035 Metropolitan Transportation Plan:

On April 10, the Assembly approved the 2035 Metropolitan Transportation Plan with some amendments. TCC proposed several recommendations, including our **request to delete from the Plan a proposal to construct a sidewalk and new multi-purpose trail along W. Northern Lights from Postmark Dr. to Nathaniel Ct.** As of this email, not sure if they were approved. **The AMATS Policy Committee will discuss the Plan on May 3rd, 9:00 a.m., City Hall, Mayor's Conference Rm- 830.**

● Legislative Funding for Alaska Community Mental Health Services to Acquire Long House Alaskan Hotel

During the April 5th TCC legislative teleconference, Rep. Lindsey Holmes announced that funding for acquisition of the Long House Alaskan Hotel for severely mentally ill housing was not included in this year's state budget. A major concern was the lack of community outreach regarding the proposal.
