Minutes of Tudor Area Community Council, September 2012

The meeting was called to order by Tod Butler, Chair, at 7:10 pm

A motion was made and passed to approve the agenda and minutes.

Elvi Gray-Jackson and Dick Traini both provided an Assembly report covering an anticipated city budget shortfall, a proposed \$50,000 appropriation to supply Tasers to all city police and a proposed change to the new sidewalk ordinance.

There were no legislative reports but interested parties can check their representative's websites.

Tod gave a short report on the May 2012 FCC meeting.

There were no scheduled guest speakers however Dick Traini and Andy Josephson introduced themselves as candidates for the state House seat in the new District 15. Harriet Drummond introduced herself as a candidate for the state House seat in District 16, both of which are part of the TACC area.

Under old business the nomination and election of Community Council officers was postponed until a one month notice of election could be published. No follow up was done on inquiry of traffic calming measures was done nor getting out meeting info to other residents of our Council through the USPS direct mail program. Snow dumping adjacent to the wetlands was brought up no conclusion for monitoring.

Under new business there was some discussion about traffic safety around the Tudor/MacInnes intersection. Julie Renwick had observed two accidents where people were making legal u turns in the median by the fire station to travel west from the eastbound Tudor lanes. There was also discussion about bicyclists travelling west or east on the Tudor bike path not being noticed by drivers turning onto Tudor from MacInnes.
