A Joint Turnagain/Spenard Council Committee is being formed to more closely follow the proposal for Anchorage Community Mental Health Services to acquire the Long House Alaskan Hotel on Wisconsin St. for the purpose of converting it into a 48-bed housing complex for severely mentally ill residents. The Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority Board of Directors is considering approving funding for the Long House property acquisition at their meeting in January 30-31, 2013 in Juneau.
