Rather than choosing one of the 5 alternatives presented last May, the phased approach incorporates 4 out of the 5 alternatives, including additional cargo-related development in Postmark and Turnagain Bogs closer to Turnagain as well as a second, widely-spaced North-South Runway in Phase 4.

Key Items in Plan:

- Phased Plan incorporates all projects from Alts. 1, 2, 3 & 5, including...
- Relocation of Postmark Dr. to east; cargorelated development in Turnagain Bog closer to Turnagain neighborhood
- Second North-South Runway in Phase 4; would allow simultaneous take-offs to north and destroy Pt. Woronozof Park & part of existing Coastal Trail and put massive amount of fill in Anchorage Coastal Wildlife Refuge
- Potential Ground Run-up
 Enclosure in Postmark Bog
 (pending FAA project and funding approval through Airport Part 150 Noise Study Mitigation Measures Implementation)

The Airport's Storm Drain Project, which will direct run-off from East Airpark through piping along International Airport Rd., Postmark Dr. and into Cook Inlet, is continuing. Construction through General Aviation Alpha parking lot is done; construction through Bravo and Charlie parking lots is projected to be completed in October.
