7:06 Guest Presentations (20 minutes)

McPherson, HDR, Merrill Field 5 year Master Plan scope and procedure (20 min)

- Handout: “How do we describe Aircraft Noise”
- Master Plan req. by FAA every 10 years
 - Hired noise consultant on handout, setting-up noise measuring equipment for Summer & Winter, calibrate noise model, map noise w/ patterns and plane types
 - If noise levels exceed threshold, then federal funding for noise abatement or property acquisition
 - Can also create rules for flight patterns
- Kemplen: Peak traffic during fall for hunting and fishing traffic. Why only two periods of measurement? Are open to consider more than two periods?
 - McPherson: Yes, open. Noise measurement not required by FAA. Airport is going extra effort for modeling. H2H already monitored baseline noise. Two weekends in June (past peak traffic), but FAA looking for average noise.
- Kemplen: Air traffic generates noise off and near runway, but FAA model only in pattern? Noise complaints off pattern.
 - McPherson: FAA Model for runway and flight pattern. Noise workshop in June to discuss noise model with consultant firm. Also incorporating complaint pattern
- Kemplen: Noise workshop scheduled in midtown during community council meeting. Would participation from residents be improved without the conflict?
 - McPherson: Will come to this location for meeting at agreeable time.
- H. Need: Cited may complaint. What sanctions exist?
 - Jumao-As: Call Field Manager, Log complaint, call tower, call pilot, file report to FAA, then FAA jurisdiction. Sanction is unknown by field manager.
- Scollan: What is a legitimate complaint / violation?
 - Jumao-As: Outside of traffic pattern, fly down 7th to Gambell, if anywhere else, not in pattern, also policy to fly-friendly, most
- Heinrich: Is there possibility to train unfamiliar pilots with the pattern?
 - McPherson: Most complaints from out-of-town pilots. Pilots from outside the traffic pattern. Perhaps a public information campaign or additional information for tower.
- Scollan: When new maps? RuralCAP cannot purchase new property in noise area.
 - McPherson: New maps available in 1 year.
- Kemplen: FAA minimum safe altitudes over congested areas is 1,000' above highest obstacle, except when necessary for takeoff or landing. At Merrill Field 1,200'. FAA special guidance 7/13/2011 Letter to Airmen (submitted as comment “ATCT Letter to

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Airmen 11-01" traffic pattern for Merrill Field: Ingra to 15th. Pilots that fly out of pattern is a violation. FAA can suspend licensure for repeat offenders.
