

Fairview Community Council Resolution No. 2012-06 *CS*

A Resolution supporting a legislative request for capital funds to support activities related to public safety and emergency preparedness in Fairview

Whereas, the Fairview Community Council sees a need to advise and educate area residents, business people and property owners about crime prevention activities; and

Whereas, regular newsletters and presentations can facilitate the delivery of information about crime prevention; and

Whereas, much of the equipment used by the Fairview Community Council's community patrol is obsolete; and

BY ~~Whereas, there is a need to scientifically document the effects of social service agencies on property values and business viability in Fairview; and~~

Whereas, the Fairview Community Council recognizes a need for the neighborhood to have some capacity to manage a natural disaster or other large-scale emergency; and

Whereas, at present the neighborhood lacks adequate resources to manage such an event; and

Whereas, Fairview is a neighborhood in a winter city; and

Whereas, snow removal is a public safety issue in that lack of adequate snow removal deters people from walking on sidewalks and promotes walking in roadways; and

Whereas, a neighborhood-level effort to address crime, prepare for emergencies, and remove snow can serve to increase collective efficacy and the quality of life in Fairview.

Therefore, Be it Resolved that the Fairview Community Council supports the attached request to the Alaska State Legislature for funds over a three-year period to support activities related to public safety and emergency preparedness in Fairview, and

Be It Further Resolved that the Fairview Community Council requests that Anchorage Mayor Dan Sullivan communicate his support for the attached request to the Alaska State Legislature.
