A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTH ADDITION COMMUNITY COUNCIL RECOMMENDING THAT THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AND THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT POST ILLEGAL CAMPING NOTICES FOLLOWING ANY ABATEMENT OF AN ILLEGAL CAMP IN THE SOUTH ADDITION COMMUNITY COUNCIL AREA

WHEREAS, the South Addition Community Council (“SACC”) has concerns that the increasing number of illegal camps in our South Addition community parks is causing safety and fire concerns as well as increased crime in our parks and recreational areas and also spilling into our residences and yards; and

WHEREAS, SACC has a vested interest in ensuring public spaces represent the character of its neighborhood and are safe places; and


WHEREAS, there is a 15 day abatement period delay in the removal of illegal camps in any areas that do not have posted signage warning that camping is illegal in the park; and

WHEREAS, SACC supports more signage so that illegal camping is discouraged and so that debris and waste products can be promptly removed from the park;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

SACC hereby supports and requests that whenever the Municipality of Anchorage has to abate an illegal camp that is in the South Addition Community Council area that the Municipality promptly erects signage that no camping is permitted in the area as a part of the abatement process.

PASSED AND APPROVED by the South Addition Community Council this 19th day of May, 2016 by a vote of 11 in favor; 3 opposed, and 1 abstention.
