

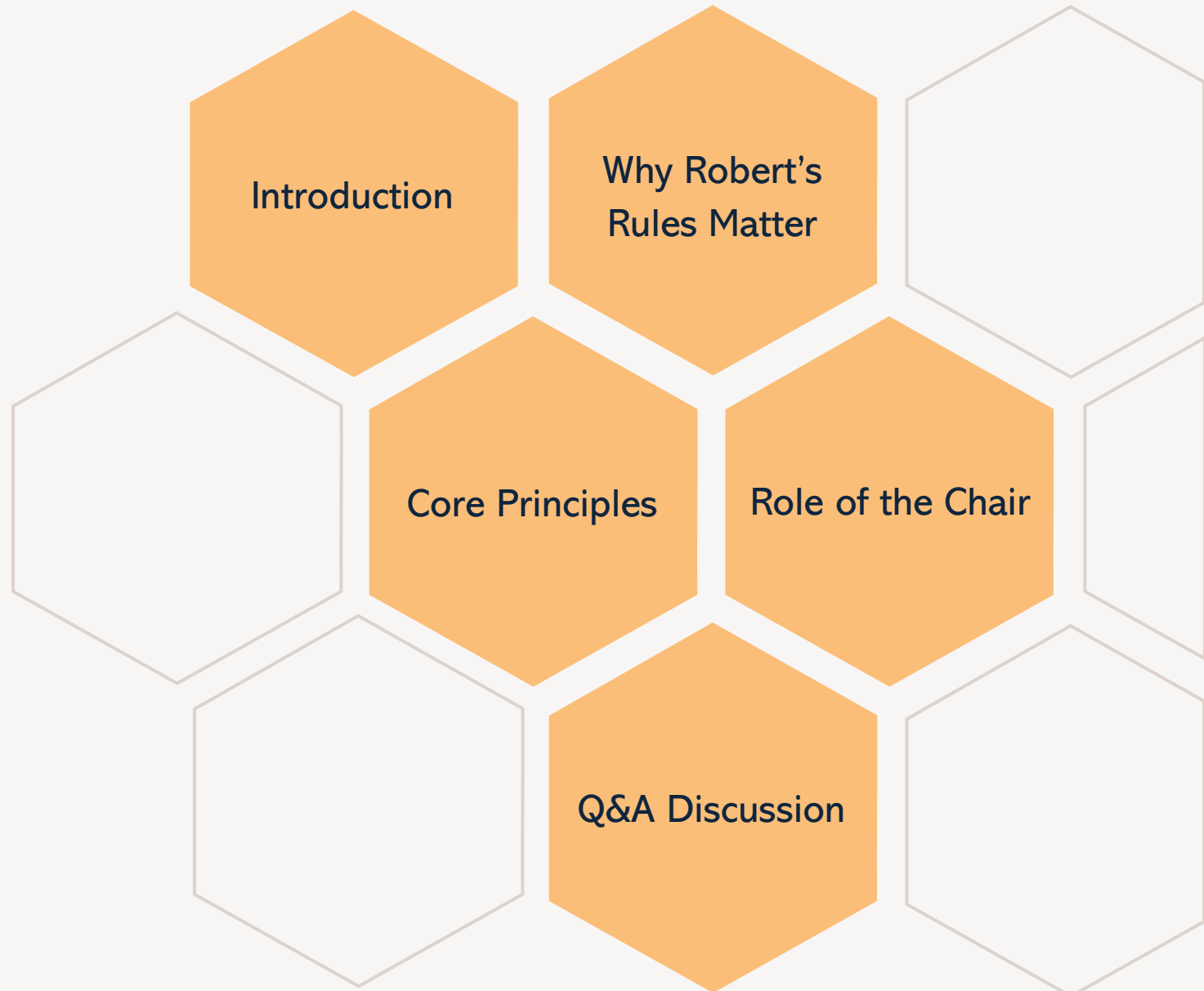

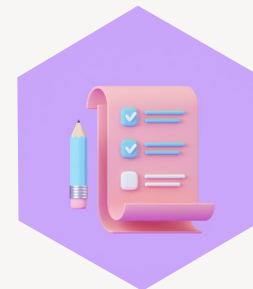

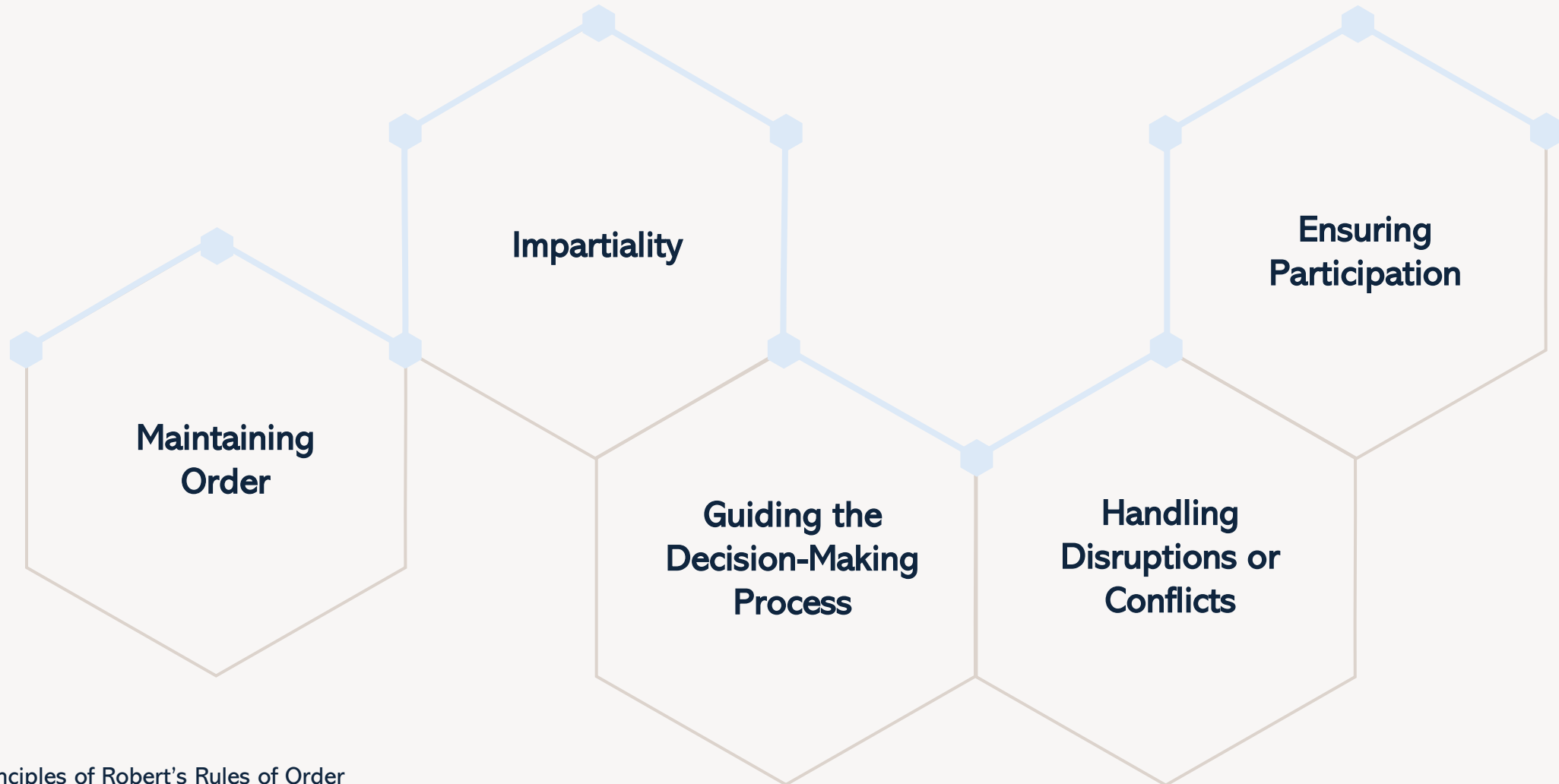

Secretary

- Records Minutes
- Tracks Motions
- Ensures Documentation



Treasurer

- Provides Financial Reports
- Ensures Transparency



Vice Chair/Vice President

- Assists the Chair
- Presides in the Chair's Absence
