The Municipal Code Changed for Community Council Rules

On Tuesday February 11, 2014, the Municipal Assembly passed an ordinance that changes the Municipal Code providing for the "Establishment, Recognition, Duties, and Responsibilities Related to Community Councils". These changes require each council to submit their bylaws to the Assembly in the near future.

The sample bylaws meet all the requirements of the legislation and can be used as a guideline for rewriting your council's bylaws. There is also a version that includes markups in red that show the purpose of each section. These markups were created by Darrel Hess, who had a lot to do with the writing of the legislation.
