- I. Call to order at 5:35 PM by the Chair, Deirdre Cronin. Welcome and introductions.
 - II. **It was moved, duly seconded and approved that the May 4, 2006 minutes be approved.**
 - III. No treasurers report
 - IV. No appearances. It was noted that Kim MacBeath was leaving the council and the state. The members appreciated her long service with the council. **It was moved, duly seconded and approved that: The Downtown Community Council shall spend up to \$75.00 to purchase a “thank you and going away” gift for Kim MacBeath.**
 - V. **Old Business:** Because of the completion of the McKinley Tower it was decided to remove it from the Old Business agenda as a regular item.

Pattee stated that the owner was a holder of a liquor license for many years at two different locations and that she wished to begin “dinner” service at the Kodiak Café and that a full Beverage Dispensary license would be an enhancement to her operation.
