### Trail Issues

• <u>Hand Tram Renovation</u>—During the past month, a small child fell off the platform of the tram and down the slope to the creek. The tram did not fail mechanically.

Aerial Tramways will be here in early October. Jonnie will ask them for an estimate letter after their visit.

- <u>Letter to USFS—Bridge</u>—Discussion continued about support for a bridge near the hand tram. Opinions varied widely. Ideas discussed: Alison will talk to the Fire Department to see if further rescue training is advisable for the tram; Jonnie asked if the Trails Committee would agree to a \$3,000 liability insurance policy, paid through GBOS; and a trail could be built down to the creek for emergency access.
- <u>Improvements to Deb's Way</u>—Kate mentioned that next summer's trail work might include gravel and ditching of Deb's Way. It currently is dangerous because of the mud and angle of the hill. The Committee agreed, and Jonnie will find out what utility has the easement.

Matt, Chief Ranger for CSP, is researching the history of the CA Creek Trailhead to see how Girdwood should respond to the proposal to take it over from CSP. Matt will forward what he finds to the Committee.

*MoU—MOA Legal---*Jonnie reported that Janice Crocker, GBOS Parks and Recreation Supervisor, is investigating the lag time. Jonnie will contact the Committee when she hears from Janice.

*Moose Meadow Trailhead*—Jonnie presented the concept to GBOS last month will go again this month.

*New Nordic Loop*—There will be no work this summer because the Nordic Ski Club is still finding funds to finish the project.

Beaver Pond Trail System Easements and Survey—Jonnie brought the completed survey maps of the system, and the final documents for the easement should be completed by January 2012. She will ask to have the maps put on the Girdwood Trail Committee website.

Members agreed that our next easement project should be the Iditarod realignment in the lower valley.

The CA Creek bridge in the lower valley is broken again.

The Forest Service has been granted an easement for the Winner Creek Trail through HLB lands. This new easement is from the "T, across the gorge bridge, then

to Crow Creek Road. They need this in order to replace the Winner Creek Gorge bridge, which is being widened to accommodate mechanized trail maintenance and emergency vehicles.

Jonnie mentioned that both Carolyn and Kate are in their last months of service as officers for Trails, and new officers will need to be elected in December or January.
