- a balanced transportation system that allows families and children to travel safely without having to drive a car;
- a safe, healthy, clean northern city where our children will be proud to live and raise their children;
- open spaces, wetlands, trails and recreational spaces throughout the Anchorage Bowl and today, especially in midtown along the University and Russian Jack Trails;
- neighborhoods near Bragaw and Elmore Roads that are working to preserve the trails, wetlands and recreational spaces between Northern Lights Boulevard and Providence Drive as open spaces;
- efforts to protect the health and safety of students attending East High School, Russian Jack Elementary, Alaska Native Charter School along Bragaw north of University lands;

 alternatives may be considered.
