- **Municipality of Anchorage Reapportionment:** The Assembly is considering new district options for Anchorage. After deliberation and significant public input, the Assembly extended the original Reapportionment timeline to allow for community consideration and due diligence on this very important matter.

Three public hearings have been held, and the Assembly voted to move one map forward: **Weddleton/Wells Map 11v2**; all other maps were archived, including those that proposed reapportioning Hillside residents (District 6) into Eagle River (District 2). There are currently two proposed amendments to Map 11v2. The Assembly will deliberate on all proposed amendments at a special meeting on March 23, 2022.

Timeline: There is a Reapportionment Committee work session on 3/18/22 at 9:30am; a Special Assembly meeting on 3/23/22 at 6:00pm; and another Committee meeting, if needed, on 3/24/22 (time TBD).
