## Resolution of Support for Pedestrian and Driver Safety Improvements in the Municipality of Anchorage, including Muldoon Road

**WHEREAS**, the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) and the Municipality of Anchorage have reported a significant increase in pedestrian fatalities in 2024, highlighting the urgent need for safety improvements; **and** 

**WHEREAS**, the NECC is committed to supporting the goal of Vision Zero, which seeks to eliminate fatalities and serious injuries on Anchorage roads; **and** 

**WHEREAS**, the DOT&PF has identified that limited street lighting, high vehicle speeds, and the need for greater public awareness have been recognized as contributing factors to pedestrian fatalities, particularly in high-risk corridors such as Tudor Road, Muldoon Road, and Bragaw Street; **and** 

**WHEREAS,** Muldoon Road in particular has high vehicle traffic, concentrated transit usage, and high speed in this dense residential area of Anchorage; **and** 

**WHEREAS**, there were previous efforts by the Northeast Community Council (NECC) advocating for safe pedestrian safe crossings on Muldoon Road, such as suggested underpass/overpass from Creekside Center area to Chanshtnu Muldoon Park;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the NECC supports the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities and the Municipality of Anchorage in their efforts to:

- 1. Install improved street lighting in identified high-risk areas;
- 2. Reduce speed limits on key roadways;
- Promote public education campaigns to inform drivers and pedestrians of their responsibilities;
- 4. Strengthen enforcement of traffic laws to enhance safety for all road users;

And in particular for Muldoon Road:

- 5. Implement permanent radar feedback speed signs;
- 6. Reduce distances between well marked pedestrian crossings by considering a pedestrian only crossing near Old Harbor and Muldoon intersection;
- 7. Construct an underpass or overpass from Creekside Center area to Chanshtnu Muldoon Park;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the NECC urges timely implementation of these measures and encourages all residents to adhere to the new safety initiatives for the benefit of the community.
