



**Resolution Requesting Speed Humps to Reduce Traffic Speeds on Trafford Drive
Within the Northeast Community Council in the Municipality of Anchorage**

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage has seen an increase in pedestrian fatalities the last two years;

WHEREAS, the pedestrian safety is an adopted priority of the Municipality of Anchorage through the Vision Zero initiative as well as by the Anchorage Metropolitan Area Transportation Solutions (AMATS) Safety Plan;

WHEREAS, speed humps have been shown to reduce car crashes and improves pedestrian safety;

WHEREAS, many residents living on Trafford Drive have children, and unintentional motor vehicle crashes are the leading cause of child and adolescent mortality in the United States (CDC, 2015);

WHEREAS, residents living on Trafford Drive have repeatedly observed speeding issues including crashes and damage to private property over the years;

WHEREAS, that Trafford Drive is a residential street has become an ad hoc commuter “through way” for drivers moving east/west though the area despite nearby commuter streets designed for that purpose;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage has recently installed speed humps on nearby residential streets to Trafford Drive on Oklahoma Street and Fredricks Drive;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Northeast Community Council requests the Municipality of Anchorage and the Assembly to prioritize the installation of speed humps on Trafford Drive.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Northeast Community Council will consider making this request a priority when developing and submitting CIP project requests to the Municipality of Anchorage.
