NECC Voting Process

NECC Member Eligibility

- 1. Live within the NECC boundaries
- 2. Sign in at each meeting and provide current information at the door or if a Zoom participant provide current information
- 3. Only one person per household may hold an office at the same time
- 4. NECC members will be provided with a voting card once eligibility is confirmed. A voting card must be raised when voting or to receive a ballot.
- 5. Community Councils are nonsectarian and nonpartisan

Per the Muni Charter: 2.40.036 – Community council bylaws, Article XIV: Dissolution, Para 13. "Conflict of interest. Community councils shall not endorse a candidate for federal, state, or municipal elected office." (received from FCC March 29, 2024)

Qualifications to vote at NECC meeting

- 1. Live or own property, business, or a nonprofit in the NECC boundary
- 2. Present in-person at a meeting, or an individual Zoom attendee
- 3. Resident one vote
- 4. If one person owns property & a business one vote
- 5. Business owners and nonprofits must identify and have on record one primary representative & alternate who will be acknowledged if the primary representative **is not** in attendance one vote
- 6. No individual, business, or non-profit or combination may hold more than one vote
- 7. May vote when signed in at Northeast Council meeting and meets the qualifications above (#1-#5) as specified in the bylaws
- 8. No proxies

Note: Municipality of Anchorage Community Council boundaries do not include JBER residents. (see Anchorage FCC map) Community Council map)

Sign-in for in-person voting

- 1. Check ID with name & physical address required
- 2. Each person must print clearly, sign-in, and complete all information
- 3. Information provided will be confirmed to deem NECC eligible
- 4. Search filtered database & if needed, muni argis, property search confirm eligible
- 5. A voting card will **only** be given to those whose eligibility is confirmed as qualified NECC voters prior to the vote taken. Cards must be returned at the end of the meeting.

Vote in-person by ballot

- 1. Ballots may be used as a preferred voting method throughout the year.
- 2. Ballots will contain the following options: Yeah, Nay, Abstain
- 3. Ballots will be distributed to confirmed, eligible NECC members.

Zoom sign-in

Participants must provide full name, residence resident, business owner, property owner, nonprofit within the NECC boundaries – drop information & snapshot of documentation with name and home address into manager chat:

- a) Alaska Driver's License/State ID and recently issued voter ID card/electric bill with name/address
- b) Phone numbers, nicknames, or bot are not accepted

Zoom voting poll

- 1. One person, one vote, one apparatus allotted per voting poll
- 2. Zoom eligible voters will be given access to Voting Poll and participant using a smartphone, table, or computer
- 3. Only one qualified voter per apparatus. A second eligible voter may elect to provide personal data and vote in the manager chat feature no secret voting capabilities in this instance
- 4. Zoom call-in option participants may elect to provide personal data and vote openly no promise that this process is achievable no secret voting capabilities in this instance.
- 5. Zoom poll time will not be extended and poll will not be reissued.

Time allotted for voting – 3 minutes maximum both Zoom & in-person

Voting

- 1. In-Person secret ballot
- 2. Zoom eligible voters will be given access to Voting Poll
- 3. Zoom call-in only allows the participant to be heard and to speak, secret ballot is not possible
- a. Call in Zoom available to eligible voting members if they can be vetted prior to Voting and are willing to open vote there is no means to take a secret or semi-private vote
- 4. Presenters, guest & unconfirmed or ineligible voters will be placed on hold in the Zoom waiting room during voting poll
- 5. One person, one ballot

Voters may mark up to 3 nominees on ballot

Vote for more than 3 nominee's names or more than one mark per nominee – ballot/poll will be rejected Replacement ballot or voting poll will not be issued
