At the next meeting we will hear a presentation by the folks from Walgreens. Please note they are in the very early design stages.

They would like to tell us what they have planned and are seeking community member input in order to discover what we believe would be a good fit in the Huffman area. They have been making an effort to reduce their impact to their neighbors just south of their property with fencing and landscaping plans.

The planned site for the store is on the Southeast corner of Huffman Road and Brandon Street. At the meeting they will have poster boards with elevations, site plans and handouts to take with you.

They are hoping to have as many neighbors as possible at the meeting to get the word out. So please, invite anyone you know in our area that may not be regulars at our meetings.

### Old Seward Construction Update

The latest news about the Old Seward expansion was presented to the Council by James Amundsen of DOT at the October 8th meeting.

It was reported that the time line for the construction has once again been delayed due to unforeseen issues. Those have since been resolved and the project went out to bid the end of October. Our community should be expecting construction beginning May of 2009.

The Old Seward expansion project will be from south of O'Malley Road to Brandon Road. The highway will be five lanes north of Huffman. The intersection of Old Seward and Huffman will have a round-a-bout. The project will also include replacing a natural gas line, and sewer and water extensions south of Klatt Road.

The project will take two seasons with completion expected around November of 2010. Construction is anticipated to be 24/7 with intermittent weekend closures at Klatt & Old Seward to install the natural gas line. Traffic should remain two lanes during the construction.

### **Neighborhoods in Our Community**




















Our Council area is a coastal community overlooking Turnagain Arm in Southwest Anchorage. Below is a map of the Council area.
