- **2025 Mayor's [Community Grants](#)** applications accepted Feb 11 to Mar 10, 2025, for \$315,000 available to local charities and nonprofits for projects around Mayor LaFrance's policy priorities: public safety (e.g., activating public space, behavioral health), housing (e.g., workforce development, addressing homelessness), preparedness (e.g., energy security, weather emergencies), and beyond.
