

August 3, 2020 Indigenous Place Naming: Project Update South Addition CC

Greetings South Addition community,

On May 28<sup>th</sup> our project team attended the South Addition Community Council meeting and shared a presentation about the Indigenous Place Naming initiative. We heard community feedback regarding the existing funds and plans to install a Chanshtnu place name sign at Westchester Lagoon. During this presentation we shared a potential location that was being considered at the entrance to the new bird viewing platform near the 15<sup>th</sup> Ave. parking lot.

After additional site visits and coordination with MOA Parks and Recreation Department, we have selected an alternative location. We would like to keep the community updated on the progress of this project and welcome feedback regarding this new location. Please see the attached diagram for details of the new placement. The attached updated site plan shows two different configurations for the site. We are working with Anchorage Park Foundation and Parks and Recreation to determine the most appropriate layout of the space and based on funding.
