The Anchorage Community
Development Authority (ACDA),
through its EasyPark division, is
excited to announce the launch of
the Park It Forward: Downtown
Anchorage Grant Program—a bold
new initiative that reinvests
parking meter revenue into local
projects that spark energy,
creativity, and life in downtown
Anchorage.

The program is directly shaped by findings from ACDA's Downtown Community Survey, where 747 respondents called for:

- More public art and murals
- Vibrant public spaces and creative events
- A stronger, people-first downtown identity

Applications are open from September 18 - October 9, 2025. Awards will be announced within 4 weeks of the cycle closing.

The Mayor's Office and Anchorage Community Development Authority will host an information session for community members to learn more about the Municipality's Microunits for Recovery Residences pilot project. The information session will take place Tuesday, September 30th, 6 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at St. Mary's Episcopal Church, 2222 E. Tudor Rd., Anchorage, AK 99507. The project includes at least 24 microunits constructed this fall and located on municipal land near the Elmore Permit Center. These Recovery Residences will help address Anchorage's need for transitional



housing for people experiencing homelessness who are seeking treatment for substance use disorder.
