Muldoon Transit Center Survey

The Municipality of Anchorage is planning a new Muldoon & Debarr Transit Center to better serve riders, improve safety, and create a welcoming space for the whole community. This project will replace the current on-street bus stops with a purpose-built, off-street facility that makes transfers easier, supports bus drivers, and connects to a new public library.

This project is supported by a Federal Transit Administration Areas of Persistent Poverty (AoPP) grant and guided by the East Anchorage District Plan and Anchorage 2040 Land Use Plan.
