And, what are you willing to cut? We're not going to walk out of that meeting with a new budget, but we'll start talking about what's most important to you.

While this meeting won't be livestreamed or video recorded, we will share back some takeaways from our conversation afterwards, as well as continue to collect the public's questions about our budget and fiscal picture, and work to keep providing the information people want in order to understand where we are, and make choices in the future.
