HOME-ARP Allocation Plan Substantial Amendment #2

Notice of One Public Hearing and 15- Day Public Comment Period

The Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) announces that the Community Safety and Development HOME-ARP Allocation Plan Substantial Amendment #2 noted above is available for review and public comment. The Substantial Amendment proposes to reprogram \$550,000 in HOME-ARP funds from

non-profit operating, non-profit capacity building, and development of affordable rental housing expenses into supportive services to be provided by the Anchorage Affordable Housing and Land Trust (AAHLT).

A Public Hearing will be held on October 30, 2025 in the Z. J. Loussac Library, Wilda Marston Theater, 3600 Denali Street, Anchorage, starting at 6:00 PM. Written comments will also be accepted via email at the address listed below.

The 15-day public comment period for the above plans starts October 19, 2025 and ends at 5:00 PM November 3, 2025. Comments will be accepted by mail, email, or delivery

Community Council Boundaries - Public Hearing

The Community Council Boundaries 10-Year Review project has reached the Anchorage Assembly. The Assembly introduced the case on Tuesday (October 21) and set a **public hearing for November 4, 2025**.

The Assembly Ordinance for adoption, AO No. 2025-119 and its community council boundary maps, reflect the recommendations of the Planning and Zoning Commission from April (PZC Case No. 2024-0100). The PZC made its recommendations after holding public hearings in January and March.
