## Minnesota Dr & I/L Corridor Plan - Public Workshop #2

the Draft Corridor Plan!

The Alaska Department of Transportation  
and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) is using a  
special planning method called Corridor  
Planning for Minnesota Drive and I/L  
Streets. This approach will help combine  
how land is used, the area around it, and the  
ways people travel. Corridor Planning sees  
these roads as important areas  
that help people move around and reach  
places nearby.

The plan will help guide decisions about  
where to spend money on transportation,  
find problems with Minnesota Drive and I/L  
Streets, and explain how these roads fit into  
the larger transportation system in  
Anchorage.

## Ballots due April 7th!

Ballots are due by April 7th and there are  
multiple ways you can make sure your vote  
is counted.

**Vote at Home:** Voters are encouraged to  
vote and return their mailed ballot. If voters  
return their ballot though the mail, they  
should take their ballot to a postal counter  
and ask for a “manual postmark” to make  
sure their vote will count! The last day for  
voters to return a ballot is Tuesday, Election  
Day, April 7, 2026.

### **Return Voted Ballots to Secure Drop Box:**

There are 18 Secure Drop Boxes throughout  
the City that are open 24 hours, 7 days-a-  
week. On Election Day, April 7, 2026,

Secure Ballot Drop Boxes are open until 8:00 p.m. Voters in line at a Secure Drop Box by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day will be allowed to drop off their ballots. Voters can call the Voter Hotline at (907) 243-VOTE (8683) or search the online map of Secure Drop Box locations at [www.muni.org/elections/dropbox](http://www.muni.org/elections/dropbox) to find the location of the closest secure drop box.

**Vote in Person at an Anchorage Vote Center (AVC):** Voters may visit one of the three Anchorage Vote Centers to vote in person if voters lost, damaged, didn't receive a mailed ballot, or prefer to vote in person. Voters must have proper identification to vote in person at an Anchorage Vote Center.
